

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

# AIMS & OBJECTIVES

## AIMS

1. To help nurses develop ability to cooperate and coordinate with members of the health team in the prevention of diseases, promotion of health and rehabilitation of the sick.
2. To prepare nurses with a sound educational program in nursing to enable them to function as efficient members of health team, beginning with the competence first level position in all kind of health care system.

## OBJECTIVES

1. Apply problem solving techniques in nursing practice.
2. Participate as a member of health team in delivery of curative, preventive, promotive and rehabilitative health care services.
3. Mobilize community resources and their involvement in working with the communities.
4. Demonstrate basic skill in administration and leadership while working with other members of the health team and community.
5. Work effectively with members of health team and community applying the knowledge of human relations and communication skills in her work.





# Auxiliary Nurses and Midwifery (ANM) Course

**Duration: 2 years with internship/training**

**Total Seats: 50**

**Eligibility:**

- i. The applicant at the time of admission must have completed the age of 17 years and should not be above 30 years.
- ii. The applicant should have cleared 10+2 recognised by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.

**Medical Fitness:**

Admission is subject to satisfactory medical examination report.



**Selection Criteria:**

1. After scrutinizing the application form of candidates, only eligible candidates as per the eligibility criteria will be called for written test and interview.
2. Selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained in written examination and the interview by selection committee.
3. The weightage of 80% marks should be obtained in written test.
4. The weightage of 20% marks in interview which will test attitude, motivate and health fitness.
5. Selection will be based on the basis of Merit.
6. The decision of Selection Committee will be final.



# General Nurses and Midwifery (GNM) Course

**Duration: 3 years with internship/training**

**Total Seats : 30**

**Eligibility:**

- i. The applicant at the time of admission must have completed the age of 17 years and should not be above 30 years.
- ii. The applicant should have cleared 10+2 recognised by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.

**Medical Fitness:**

Admission is subject to satisfactory medical examination report.



**Selection Criteria:**

1. After scrutinizing the application form of candidates, only eligible candidates as per the eligibility criteria will be called for written test and interview.
2. Selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained in written examination and the interview by selection committee.

1. The School has well equipped class rooms with modern teaching aids. Students have the opportunity to gain knowledge and practical skills in various laboratories such as Nutrition Lab, Fundamental of Nursing Lab, Maternal & Child health and Community health nursing. The computer lab has internet facility to get wide range of educational information.
2. The School has a library which is well stocked with sufficient and latest volumes of books, journals, magazines and daily newspapers.
3. Students gain comprehensive experience in Maternal & Child Health, Medical and Surgical Nursing in the hospital as well as community setting.
4. The School has a spacious conference hall, well furnished and safe hostel with visiting room, recreation room , mess etc.
5. The School of Nursing is affiliated to Delhi Nursing Council (DNC), New Delhi. DNC is the examining and registration body for the nursing students. All nursing programs are affiliated to Delhi Nursing Council.
6. Brahm Shakti School of Nursing is licensed and accredited by Indian Nursing Council (INC) and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
7. The teaching program and curriculum is based on the guidelines as per the Indian Nursing Council (INC).
8. The school has highly qualified and proficient teaching faculty passed out from eminent nursing institutes and having ample teaching experience to impart effective nursing education to the aspiring students.

## 3. Transportation:

## Reasons for rejection of an application of admission

1. The candidates admission can be rejected if any discrepancy is noticed in the application form, testimonials or in age.
2. The admission can be rejected if any false or incorrect statement is found to be made by the candidates.
3. The admission can be rejected if fraudulent means are used by any candidate for getting admission.
4. The admission can be rejected if unauthenticated or false documents are attached by any candidate with the application form for seeking admission.
5. The admission can be rejected if any enrollment in any full time/part timestudy/class or course is found in respect of any candidate.
6. In addition to the above, the management reserves the right to reject the application/admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.

## Conditions of Training Termination

Training of a candidate can be terminated under the following circumstances.

- i. Two successive failures in supplementary examination of first, second and third.
- ii. Failure to carry out classroom assignments or practical work for reason other than illness or other disability
- iii. In case of gross misconduct

## List of documents required at the time of admission

1. 10<sup>th</sup> class mark sheet and passing certificate
2. 12<sup>th</sup> class mark sheet and passing certificate
3. Medical fitness certificate
4. Conduct/character certificate
5. Migration certificate
6. Transfer certificate
7. Any other certificate related to sports, competition, curricular activities any special qualification etc.
8. Six passport size photograph (3 self attested and 3 normal)



# HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. Stay in the hostel is compulsory for all the students.
2. Students are responsible for the cleanliness of their rooms.
3. Students are not permitted to keep valuables and jewellery etc at the hostel. If any student does so and any loss or damage takes place, the school authorities will not be responsible for the same.
4. Overnight and outgoing passes will be issued only twice a month. But this facility can be withdrawn as a disciplinary measure e.g. poor result, negligence in work, going without permission, other indiscipline etc. The decision of the Principal shall be final in this regard.
5. Visitors shall be permitted to meet the students between 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. only on Wednesday along with the valid identity proof and photocopy thereof. No visitor will be allowed to meet the students or enter any place other than the meeting room.
6. While going out of the hostel the students must sign in the register kept for the purpose.
7. The night attendance will be taken at 8 p.m. on daily basis. It is mandatory for all the students to be present for attendance failing which disciplinary action will be taken against the erring student including rustication.
8. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in class rooms, library, hostel and during clinical training.
9. No indiscipline, indecent activity, mischief, nuisance etc. of any kind in the school, hostel or clinical activity premises shall be permitted/tolerated at any cost. Any student found indulging in any of such activities shall be subject to stern disciplinary action with punishment including rustication.



## List of Articles Required for Hostel

Each student shall be required to bring the following items along from home at the time of admission:

1. Bed Sheets -- 3 nos
2. Bed Covers -- 2 nos
3. Pillow Covers -- 3 nos
4. Mufti clothes -- sufficient quantity to keep the student neat and clean
5. Tiffin carrier steel with 4 boxes – 1 nos
6. slippers

## Grading Examination

Examination shall be graded on the aggregate marks of the program as follows:

Distinction	- 80% and above marks
First Division	-70% to 79.9% marks
Second Division	-60% to 69.9% marks
Pass	-50% to 59.9% marks
